Dr Goh Keng Swee Dies

Former Deputy Prime Minister and Singapore's economic architect Goh Keng Swee died on May 14, 2010 at the age of 91.

Dr Goh came from a rich Malacca family and was the son of Goh Leng Inn, a manager of a rubber plantation. His mother was from the family that produced famous Malaysian politicians Tun Tan Cheng Lock and his son Tun Tan Siew Sin.

Dr Goh joined the Department of Social Welfare in 1946 and was active in post-war adminstration. He resigned from the civil service in 1959 to enter politics and was elected as the People's Action Party representative for Kreta Ayer, his constituency until he retired in 1984.

In 1959, when he became finance minister, he described the state of the economy as "wretched".

Upon Singapore's independence in 1965, Dr Goh also became Minister for the Interior and Defence until 1967, assuming responsibilities for strengthening Singapore's military and domestic security capabilities. A key policy was the creation of National Service, a mandatory

conscription system for able-bodied young males.

In 1979, Dr Goh moved on to the Education Ministry, where his Goh Report greatly influenced the development of Singapore's education system, introducing key policies such as streaming and religious education. He retired as Deputy Prime Minister in December 1984.

His body lied in state in Parliament House from May 20-22 for the public to pay their last respect. A state funeral was held on May 23 at the Singapore Conference Hall. The cortege then left for Mandai Crematorium where a private ceremony was held for family members.


